Please be advised that due to issues with weather and equipment procurement, this project's initial December completion date has been delayed. We must complete this project to provide critical flood protection and ensure public safety so it is with regret that we must extend the project timeline.

NEW SCHEDULE

Sediment hauling is now expected to be completed by late-January 2024, weather permitting.

Work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. We do not anticipate working on holidays or weekends.
